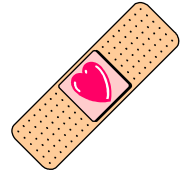


# *How We Protect Minors* *Regarding Injury:*



1. All teachers are regularly encouraged to get certified in CPR and to be trained in first-aid.
2. First aid kits are easily accessible to every room in the building.
3. All of our furniture is safe. The tables, chairs, and toys are free from sharp or pointed corners
4. Incident report forms are filled out in any event of injury even down to a paper-cut. These forms are a detailed record of what exactly happened.
5. Fire extinguishers are easily accessible to every room in the building and any church bus or van. Fire escape routes are posted on every floor of the building, as fire code regulates.
6. Whether indoors or outdoors, dangerous activities with a high potential of causing injury are not congruent with church policy. These include (but are not limited to) rough-housing, tree climbing, operating heavy/dangerous machinery, sword fighting with sticks, climbing ladders, carrying heavy objects, using non-age-appropriate tools, throwing dangerous objects at people, etc.
7. In the event of injury at the church, the hospital is a few miles away. For off-the-premises activities, we encourage usage of cell phones for emergencies.
8. To prevent minors from getting into injury-prone situations, proper supervision by mature adults is the rule.
