

Class Sequence/Lesson Plans (What to do in Class):

Mandatory Every Week:

Attendance/Registration

Story/Lesson

Something fun

Opportunity for Children to Pray to accept Christ into their lives in a greater way.

Attention Span:

The most important thing is to be mindful of your student's attention span. Some of your students will have a much shorter attention than other students. For this reason it is better to error on the side of too short than too long. This does not mean that all students should entirely change activity (for example: going from craft to lesson). All that is required are objects, motions, or something that contrasts the energy, emotion, or location of focus so that student attention is re-affixed to what is intended.

Generic Class Sequence:

1. **Registration &** Attendance checking
2. **Introduction**/Class Rules/Today's Expectations/ Announcements
3. **Something fun 1** to reinforce the lesson topic:
- 4, 5, or 6. **Question Time** (Could reward with prize points or candy):
 - Review Lesson from former week
 - Offering
 - Quick Intercessory Prayer
 - Asking/Spiritual Accountability :
 - reading the Bible
 - do you know Jesus as your savior
 - Gone through study guides at home?
- 4, 5, or 6. **Something Fun 2** (depending on time & attention span)
- 4, 5, or 6. **Story Time** (Bible)
 - Gospel presentation as applied from Bible story
 - Prayer/Altar time/PrayBC's
7. **Closing Something Fun** (especially good here are things that help the parents feel loved or that show parents their kids were loved)
8. **Dismissal**

Notes: "Something Funs" are optional depending on how much fun the story time is, how long previous things were, how much time you have left in the class, etc. Add them or subtract them as needed. "Something Fun" can be things from the curriculum that reinforce the lesson like:

Games, Prize give away/ contests, Crafts, Snacks, Activities, Etc

To Teach Regularly:

- Teach memory verses (the monthly/unit verse, or any other good verse)
- The yearly objectives

Through out the Year/s Teaching Objectives per class:

- Preschool learn Bible stories and general truths that support an understanding of a good relationship with God/salvation.
- K & 1st Grade ages should Start emphasizing the studies for new believers that are taught by mentors/shepherds.
- 2nd & 3rd grade ages should work on learning the books of the Bible
- 4th & 5th Grade
- 6th Grade
